Themes explored through the arts, presentations and group discussions:

Bahá'u'lláh's vision for humanity

We'll explore the purpose of our lives, what it means for a community to pursue its spiritual and material progress, and the ways we're all learning to work for the betterment of our communities. Bahá'u'lláh's vision is built on the belief that we are all part of one interconnected human family, sharing one precious homeland, and that everyone is created noble and has the capacity to contribute to the progress of their community and the world.

Distance traversed

We'll celebrate together how far we've come, both in Philadelphia and around the world, towards Bahá'u'lláh's vision of the types of individuals that we can become and the communities that we can build. We'll develop a common understanding of our community at present — its strengths, possibilities, challenges — and discuss our vision for the future.

Building vibrant communities

Bringing together our rich and diverse experiences, we'll discuss the characteristics of a vibrant community and reflect on how a growing culture of worship and service can contribute to the transformation of the lives of every person in our community.
